# Director's Report May 2024

Safety and Technology- Tom Rassmussen visited the Libby and Troy branches to look at our set up. He said he would contact Barb about finalizing a quote for managed services.

Tamarack Federation- Barb and I attended the Tamarack Federation Meeting in Polson. I wanted to note 2 sessions in particular: Darla Erickson, Local Government Services, presented a training on financial reports, cash flows, etc. I think it would be worthwhile to see if she would do a training with the board, if the library district initiative passes. The board will want to be well versed in this subject since the library will not have the County to lean on. The other was the Board Leadership Workshop with Ashley Kent, MSU Local Government Center. Ashley explained several laws pertaining to open meetings, right to know and more. Good knowledge to have to ensure transparency moving forward, even with staff.

Foundation Meeting- the Library Foundation met April 29. The Foundation board agreed to end its contract with The Dotted i and pursue grant writing services with another person. I have contacted the new grant writer and will work on the onboarding process after the election.

Citizen Science Kits- 3 Citizen Science Kits are available for checkout: Exploring Biodiversity, Observing Pollinators and Monitoring Air Quality. Each kit comes with a set of tools to explore a topic. We hope people will use these to get outside and explore our environment/nature. We felt this was a good time to launch this program since it lines up nicely with our Summer Reading theme "Adventure Begins at Your Library". Kits were made available with a donation from the LOR Foundation.



Maintenance- Adam secured a quote to paint the Troy exterior and it's much more reasonable than I anticipated. Waiting Board approval.

FY25 Budget- The Budget Committee and I met with the Commissioners for a preliminary budget meeting on May 7. We explained the reasons for the \$40,000 increase to the budget- including my payout for accrued leave, COLA, rising insurance costs, and unknown status of grant opportunities to cover the reduction in operating costs. The County is still in the process of meeting with other county departments for their preliminary budget hearings. I don't anticipate another budget meeting until July/August.

MSL Commission- Carmen Cuthbertson from the MSL Commission made some scathing comments towards Montana Librarians at their May 10 meeting. At the MLA Conference, librarians boycotted the "Conversations with the Commission" session, the general consensus being that the commission does not seem interested in engaging in a legitimate conversation. Members of the MSL Commission have taken extreme offense.

Library District- We are in the final stretch of the library district campaign. Staff continue to field lots of questions about the initiative. I hosted a final round of public information meetings.

Historic Items- I am doing a final review of the historic photos before finalizing the descriptions. I might not make my June 1 deadline, but I will be close! Our oral history volunteer took a quick training so he can fill out the descriptions as he listens to the recordings. This will allow us to get the oral histories uploaded much more quickly.

Eureka Temporary Hire- Jamie Brewster was temporarily hired as Library Assistant in Eureka. She will be working with Siri throughout the summer.

SRP- "Adventure Begins at Your Library" June 1. Kids will get a bag of goodies for signing up.
